7. Members Reports:

There were no reports.

8. War Memorial, Pentice site and Bus Shelters:

The Clerk reported that he, Councillor H. J. David, Councillor C. Holmes, Susan Evans (REACH) and Geoff Whittington had met that afternoon about the projects and their progress:

GW confirmed that all 3 projects will be completed and claims and supporting documentation submitted by Friday 31st October 2014.

Project work to be completed as follows:

- A. Bedford Park entrance feature – Ground works – hard-core surface and tarmac entrance. Works to the adjoining walls – rendering side wall facing Valleys to Coast property and install Estate fencing to said wall. Raised curb with raised wild flower bed next to said wall – Community Council also to explore options for seeding and maintaining this. Look at what can be done possibly tarmac around exterior of feature wall. Look at what can be done with the party wall and check with Valleys to Coast if they are responsible or for contribution towards cost.
- B. Two bus shelters by common – Rendered, painted, new roof and slate tiles. Bus Shelter which was formally war memorial - Sandblasted and new roof tiles – roof structure to be checked. Check price for painting inside.
- C. Common entrance – Foundations to be built and monoliths installed, pathway to be made good.

9. Bins at Cae Gof Playing Fields: Councillor H J David reported that he had received a request from CCAC to install more bins at Cae Gof Playing Fields. The cost of installing three bins is £1,500 and BCBC have asked for a contribution of £700 towards this. It was agreed that the Clerk would write to CCAC & CCBGC and ask them for a contribution of £200 each towards this with Council making a contribution of £300.
